	All members are busy with their programs and difficult to find time for meetings			
	• Forum members have all their own country strategies, programs, project cycles, thematic focus areas, geographical coverage, partners etc. that will make it very difficult to plan or implement joint program			
	• There are many local CSO networks that Forum members belong to, so ACT Forum does not bring much additional value development or advocacy related work, or these areas have not been really looked at.

SUMMARY OF LESSONS LEARNED	There was no major flooding in Cambodia this year, but based on our previous years experiences, ACT Forum can develop a joint response if needed			
	• It is good platform for ACT members to share and learn from each 's programme/project implementation and other issues, but it is still challenging to find a way to synergize and find key insight learning among ACT member as each member has different priority, strategy and policy
