

Why engage with the ACT Alliance


- Action by Churches Together, ACT Alliance, is the largest global ecumenical faith-based coalition organized in national and regional forums operating in more than 125 countries

The importance of faith actors


of the world's population identifies with a faith or a religion







ACT ensures stronger participation of communities and local/national organizations in the humanitarian response and promotes community resilience. Disposes of a funding mechanism to ensure quick and effective response, while addressing humanitarian advocacy

ACT challenges patriarchal, social and cultural structures and creates an enabling environment for gender justice. ACT Alliance counters the backlash against women's rights, including their sexual and reproductive health and rights, and LGBTIQ+ discrimination by creating a new narrative that positions faith-based actors and communities

ACT implements actions aimed at resolving conflict and promoting peace, focusing on women and young people. ACT Alliance supports and develops programs to prevent violence and hate speeches by addressing the root causes of conflict and strengthening a community's robustness to manage potential conflicts in the future


ACT contributes to the full, inclusive and ambitious implementation of the Paris Agreement and the SDGs. It works to influence transformational change for a just transition to more sustainable systems and structures. It focuses on loss and damage, climate-induced migration, climate finance, capacity building, human rights frameworks and gender justice

ACT advocates for the human rights of migrants and displaced and ensure that their voices are heard. ACT is faith and rights based, impact focused, committed to working ecumenically and inter-religiously, with the communities we seek to serve and accompany. Our members respond in areas where poverty and injustice occur, regardless of location.


Why Multi-stakeholder partnerships
